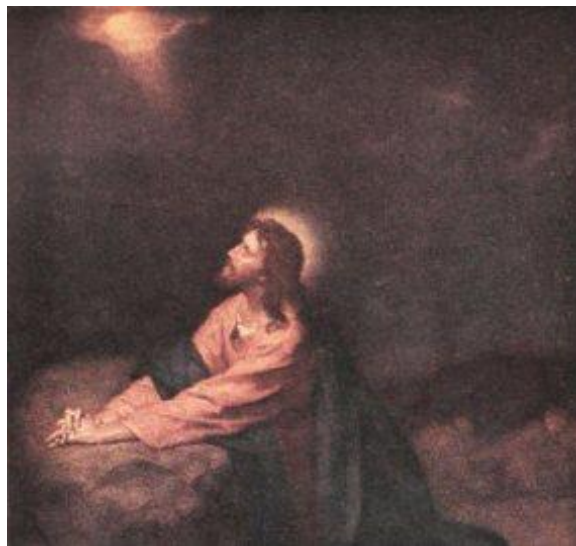

THE FIRST SORROWFUL MYSTERY: THE AGONY IN THE GARDEN

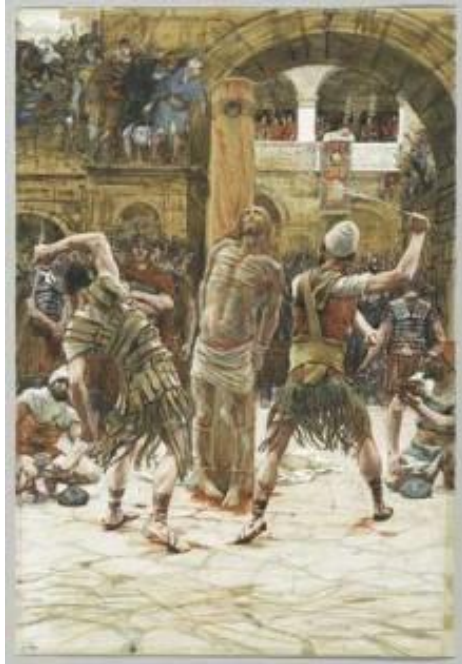

THE SCOURGING AT THE PILLAR**

Then Pilate said, "I find no guilt in this man. I will therefore chastise Him and release Him." Pilate then took Jesus and had Him scourged.

Oppressed and condemned, He was taken away, a man of suffering. Though He was harshly treated, He submitted, like a lamb led to the slaughter. He was pierced for our offenses, crushed for our sins. THE CROWNING WITH THORNS**

And bending the knee before Him they mocked Him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" And they spat on Him, and took the reed and kept striking Him on the head. Pilate again went outside and said, "I bring Him out to you, that you may know that I find no guilt in Him."

Jesus therefore came forth, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple cloak. And Pilate said to them, "Behold the man!" But they cried out, "Away with Him! Crucify Him!"
