These strategies result in millions of dollars of losses in 'futures' trades, 'option' trades, buying land in the Metaverse, revaluing Iran currency, or having a prince from Nigeria fall in love with you. People spend all of their time, running with the herd, and striving for 0.10% more, but avoiding the big mistake could double or triple your money for retirement. Yes, you will make mistakes, and nobody truly
