DAY 2 MONDAY, MAY 25

Diocese of St. Augustine to Diocese of Savannah

Begin Christ the King Catholic Church, Jacksonville

Continue to St. Michael Catholic Church, Fernandina Beach

Handover *The Eucharistic procession will cross the St. Marys' River into Georgia, where it will be entrusted to the Diocese of Savannah —continuing the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage in faith-filled unity.*

As the United States approaches its 250TH anniversary, a National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will begin in the nation's oldest Catholic city, linking the earliest chapter of Catholic life in this land with a new generation of pilgrims carrying the Eucharist across the country.
